Container refund scheme offers huge windfall within first six months

MORE THAN 440 million containers have been returned in the first six months of Queensland's container refund scheme.

Queensland's Containers for Change recently passed the six month milestone since the program was started, and Minister for Environment Leeanne Enoch said the initiative had been an incredible success.

"This scheme has created more than 630 new jobs and continues to go from strength to strength - providing financial incentives for recycling containers and encouraging more business opportunities and jobs across Queensland," Ms Enoch said.

"It has also created a fund-

# Container refund scheme offers huge windfall within first six months

ing stream for our charities and community groups.

"With more than 440 million containers returned, this means more than \$44 million has been returned to individuals, charities and community organisations."

Under the scheme, people receive a 10-cent refund for recycling their cans and bottles at refund points across the state.

"It has been wonderful to see Queenslanders embracing this recycling opportunity over the past six months," Minister Enoch said.

"The popularity of the scheme had exceeded expectations from the beginning, and

the volume of returned containers is about a third higher than predicted.

"This success has meant more jobs have been created, and that will continue to grow.

"Queensland is also becoming a much cleaner place, thanks to the public's enthusiasm for the scheme that refunds 10 cents per container."

More than 168,900 Queenslanders have a Scheme ID with Containers for Change, along with more than 2,290 community groups, schools, charities and sporting clubs, which are benefiting from the refunds.

Ken Noye, CEO of Container Exchange (COEX), the

not-for-profit organisation that runs the scheme, said as well as the new Hervey Bay depot, new depots have opened in Cooroy, Yamanto and Airlie Beach in recent weeks.

"We now have more than 270 sites accepting containers for refunds, and by December we expect to have a total of 307 sites operating, providing jobs for even more people," Mr Noye said.

"COEX will continue to grow the Containers for Change scheme to provide more refund points, more jobs and more refunds on containers," he said.

## LABOR TO DELIVER FOR THOSE IN FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

AT A press conference held on Tuesday May 7 at the Buderim Tavern, Labor Ministers and Labor Candidate for Fairfax Julie McGlone outlined their plan to help those experiencing financial hardship within the Fairfax electorate if a Labor Government is elected.

A Shorten Labor Government will provide \$40 million over four years to emergency relief organisations across the country, including \$166,000 for Integrated Family & Youth Services (IFYS) Maroochydore.

The Morrison Government is cutting the funding for many emergency relief services at the end of the year.

In Fairfax, Labor will deliver \$166,000 for IFYS Maroochydore – reversing the Liberals' cuts and providing a much-needed funding boost for the organisation.

Ms McGlone said that

IFYS provides essential services to young people on the Sunshine Coast.

"IFYS provides opportunities, in accepting environments, for children, young people and families to take responsibility for their own lives and to assist them to actively participate in the community of their choice."

IFYS provides support to vulnerable people, including a large cohort of young people, who have nowhere else to turn, by providing food hampers, funding for fuel to attend specialist medical appointments and other financial assistance.

"It's exactly this kind of service that should be supported by government, not slashed by the heartless cuts of the Morrison government – thankfully, a Shorten Labor team sees the value in people, and we will put the human back into government," Ms

McGlone said.

Other areas where a Shorten Labor Government intend to help those in financial hardship include:

- Doubling the number of financial counsellors across the country.

- Expanding low-cost alternatives to pay day loans for low-income Australians – providing safe and fair credit options when things get tough.

- Reversing the Morrison Government's \$5.5 million cut to emergency relief organisations across the country and providing a much needed top up to the emergency relief sector.

Closing remarks noted that from Labor's perspective the coming election is a choice between Labor's plan for stronger community services, and bigger tax loopholes for the top end of town under the Liberals.

## NOOSA COUNCIL LAUNCHES AMNESTY ON DOG REGISTRATION

A DOG registration amnesty will run for the month of May to combat a rising number of unregistered dogs within the Noosa Council region.

During the amnesty, Noosa residents can register their dogs free of charge (usually \$160 or \$40 for a desexed dog) by popping into Council offices on Pelican Street in Tewantin or by submitting the online form.

Local Laws Manager Phil Amson said there's an alarming spike in the number of unregistered dogs in Noosa.

"Almost half of all dogs that come into our pound, are unregistered.

"Our officers have noticed an increase in the number of unregistered dogs in the region. - in fact, both anecdotal and statistical evidence suggests that we have between 5,000 and 8,000 unregistered dogs in Noosa," Mr Amson said.

According to the Animal Management (Cats & Dogs) Act 2008, dogs older than three months of age must be registered with Council.

Mr Amson said unregistered dogs affect the community in a number of ways.

"Dog owners may not realise that the maximum fines for owning an unregistered dog is

\$2,610, so it can be quite costly."

"We are encouraging locals with unregistered dogs to register them for free during May as part of our no-questions-asked dog registration amnesty."

This initiative is further supported by a joint venture with RSPCA Queensland to offer heavily discounted Microchipping Days at various locations around Noosa from June until the end of the year.

"We are also teaming up with RSPCA to provide \$24.95 Microchipping Days so pet owners can easily drop in to a local park and microchip their cats and dogs."

### LOCAL IDEAS SOUGHT FOR ROAD SAFETY GRANTS

APPLICATIONS are now open for the Palaszczuk Government's 2019 Community Road Safety Grants.

Transport and Main Roads Minister Mark Bailey encouraged local community groups, schools, council and not-for-profits with ideas to help promote road safety to apply for a grant.

"Road safety is everyone's business," Mr Bailey said.

"The grants program has unlocked more than \$14 million for grassroots initiatives and helps puts the power into the community's hands and enables them to deliver initiatives and ideas that can improve road safety for all

Queenslanders.

"Previously funded grants include road safety education, resources and training, learner driver mentor programs, bike education, child restraint information, and heavy vehicle fatigue management.

"It's grassroots initiatives created by our grants program that is helping to achieve improved road safety across Queensland."

"Applications close on June 7, and we encourage all eligible groups to apply. Successful applicants will be announced during Queensland Road Safety Week, in late August," he said.

Queensland organisations, including schools, local govern-

ment, non-profit and community groups, are eligible to apply for up to \$20,000 for initiatives designed to address road safety issues in their local area.

The Community Road Safety Grants Scheme is part of the Palaszczuk Government's Road Safety Strategy 2015-21, which calls on everyone in our community – government, business and citizens – to take action, whenever and wherever, to improve safety on our roads.

AN INDEPENDENT riding-for-the-disabled volunteer organisation is among six groups in the Coolum and North Shore area to receive a Federal Government Volunteer Grant.

Federal Member for Fairfax Ted O'Brien said "Volunteers play a critical role in helping build strong, resilient communities and this year we have 37 organisations across Fairfax sharing in more than \$145,000."

"The grants range between \$1,000 and \$5,000 and can be used for things like the cost of training volunteers, doing background checks where they're needed or reimbursing vol-

unteers for the cost of fuel or transport," he said.

The Sunshine Coast Mane Event is among the grant recipients and received \$5,000.

President of Sunshine Coast Mane Event, Carolyn Neville said that some of the money would be used for gardening equipment.

"We will also purchase computer equipment for volunteers to utilise in our everyday programs and some money will be set aside to help volunteers get to and from the centre."





A MOVING theatre performance comprising dance, spoken word and song was performed to a full house at the Coolum Civic Centre on Friday May 3 in support of Domestic Violence Prevention Month and was facilitated by Integrated Family Youth Service (IFYS) with the assistance of a grant from the QLD Government.

The Voice In Me asked people to be aware and to speak up, and Lauren Charman from the IFYS Coolum Community Support Office said that the performance was aimed at helping the community better understand how we as a community can help each other.

"We showed the ways that people can help, whether that be through an intervention, a phone call to the police, offering support or calling a help line," Lauren said.

The night also showed projected slides with startling figures about domestic and family violence and exactly what is violence.

"There are many things that people don't realise comprises domestic and family violence as there may not always be bruises to show for it – keeping track of someone, not allowing them to see their friends, putting them down – these are all forms of domestic and family violence," Lauren said.

"We are able to tell people to not give up and I would love to see this be an annual event however, we have to apply for a grant through the QLD government, and by doing this performance with a grant we are able to keep the event free for people to come along to."

The crowd featured families, children and adults, and whilst the topic was emotional and confronting, the audience left with a sense of hope that it is ok to speak up and to use their voice to help others.

### DAVO'S NORTHSORE BAIT & TACKLE

WITH THE great conditions we have been having, it's hard to leave the boat sitting in the shed. Out the front tuna are still in good numbers, and coral trout are still plentiful around Sunshine Reef as well as sweetlip and squire. Fishing hard to the bottom is the real key when it comes to targeting coral trout, so the sinker just above the hook is the key. Snapper are starting to come on the chew, with some nice fish coming from the Barwon Banks - the pilchard floater method has been the most productive. Pearl perch, maori cod, sweetlip and jewies have also been getting in on the action with some outstanding fish boated over the past week. Spanish mackerel are still about with plenty of fish taken on deep diving lures - the closer reefs seem to be more productive.

The Maroochy River Mouth has really turned it on this week with everything from school jew, bream, trevally and tailor moving over the bar and through the mouth on the run in tide. Whiting have been in good numbers around Black

Banks, Chambers Island and Cotton Tree - small poppers and live yabbies have proven really successful in landing the bigger fish. Early morning starts, around the Cod Hole and the mouths of Petrie and Eudlo Creeks has proved to be worthwhile for trevally, bream and flathead. Casting around the snags and rock bars up towards Dunethin Rock has seen the odd good jacks caught over the past week. Suspending hard body

lures has been perfect when targeting jacks.

The Maroochy Northshore Beaches have been fishing particularly well, with whiting, bream, dart and flathead coming from between the Life Guard Tower down to the mouth - worms, pipies and small pillies have proven the best baits for them. Tailor jew and larger flathead have been caught between Marcoola Surf Club and up to Yaroomba rocks.

The rocks at Yaroomba and Coolum have been good for squire and sweetlip, with some lucky anglers doing battle with tuna and smaller mackerel.
