MESSAGE ON BEACH INVITES TOURISTS TO COOLUM



It wasn't quite visible from space, but Visit Sunshine Coast's message displayed on the beach at Coolum made a big impression on Qantas passengers flying overhead whilst onboard a B787 Dreamliner. The Qantas flight, which departed Sydney on Saturday, offered travellers an aerial tourism experience across state borders to reignite the joy of flying and experience iconic Australian destinations from the sky. As the plane over-passed Coolum Beach at 3,000 feet passengers had a bird's eye view of the message - VISIT US FOR REAL - written on the sand with vinyl letters normally used for sign writing in the sky. Coolum congestion set to be busted if LNP form government

THE NOTORIOUSLY congested Coolum roundabout on Sth Coolum Road is set to be upgraded if an elected LNP Government takes office at the end of this month - with the LNP committing to a \$30million spend which will include the Sth Coolum Rd roundabout upgrade and new Mt Coolum on-ramps to the Sunshine Motorway.

If the LNP form government, the investment is expected to also create some 100 local jobs.

LNP Deputy Leader and Shadow Treasurer Tim Mander made the announcement late last week with Ninderry MP Dan Purdie and Maroochydore MP Fiona Simpson.

The commitment involves upgrades to the roundabout on Yandina Coolum Road, parking and traffic improvements around Coolum State School, as well as two new south-facing ramps at Mt Coolum connecting

AS A Qantas B787 Dreamliner flew over Coolum, a message to the NSW passengers told the travellers that the coast was ready and waiting for their return when borders were reopened.

The region's tourism body used letters more than two metres tall to invite travellers onboard the sold-out Great Southern Land scenic flight of Australia to start planning their next Sunshine Coast escape.

The Qantas flight, which departed Sydney on Saturday, offered travellers an aerial tourism experience across state borders to reignite the joy of

flying and experience iconic Australian destinations from the sky.

The Sunshine Coast was the first destination in Australia to greet travellers with an on-ground activation, and Visit Sunshine Coast (VSC) Interim CEO Craig Davidson said he hoped the message to Sydney travellers was loud and clear.

"We miss you and can't wait to welcome you back to the Sunshine Coast when it is safe to travel again," he said.

"New South Wales has traditionally been our strongest interstate market, and as we head out of the school holiday period, we are missing them

more than ever.

"We hope this grand gesture will remind them how much they love the Sunshine Coast and inspire them to stop dreaming and start planning their next visit."

The message was supported by special onboard commentary about the Sunshine Coast, with passengers gifted a 'taste' of the region with locally made Kokopod Chocolate.

The beach activation comes as VSC plans to unveil a new campaign underpinned by the Sunshine Coast's real experiences, real people and real nature.

Coolum congestion set to be busted if LNP form government



An elected LNP state government will commit to spending \$30million in an effort to stop the daily congestion at the 5th Coolum Rd roundabout near Coolum Primary. The election funding will also include new on ramps to the Sunshine Motorway at Mt Coolum. to the Sunshine Motorway.

The new partial interchange will link to Sunshine Coast Council's proposed South Coolum Road connection on the west of Mt Coolum near Sun-coast Beach Drive.

Mr Mander said the stimulus road funding will come from its \$1bn SEQ Congestion Program, which aims to create new jobs by delivering dozens of new road and rail projects across the region.

"An LNP Government will kick-start this project because the Sunshine Coast needs more jobs and less congestion," Mr Mander said.

"One of the levers the states can pull to stimulate the economy is creating jobs with infrastructure like these road upgrades."

"Infrastructure expenditure has been cut by a staggering \$12 billion by Labor over the last five years and the LNP believes in building infrastructure and creating jobs here on the Sunshine Coast," Mr Mander said.

"This investment in Coolum

and Mt Coolum will create 93 construction jobs and we will back local contractors to get the job done."

LNP MP for Ninderry Dan Purdie said he had campaigned for action on the dangerous road conditions for three years, but all Labor had produced was a review.

"The LNP will fast-track this project and get shovels in the ground," Mr Purdie said.

"The first step will be to conduct a full network assessment in conjunction with council and then we will get building."

"Congestion is one of the top issues affecting locals, particularly in Coolum, where the population has increased dramatically over the past decade," Mr Purdie said.

Most afternoons and mornings traffic grinds to a standstill at Coolum State School, where it backs right up to the Sunshine Motorway.

Mr Purdie further went on to say that the LNP will invest for growth, bust congestion and future-proof the local road network.

"The LNP's \$30million

investment in our local road infrastructure will not only mean commuters get home sooner and safer, it will also provide desperately needed jobs and help stimulate our local economy."

Ms Simpson said the \$30m LNP road package was a smart network solution to a bad traffic problem affecting the greater Coolum area and two electorates.

"The new connection to the Motorway will stop rat-running through the greater Mt Coolum and Yaroomba area and take pressure off Yandina-Coolum Rd/South Coolum Rd intersection near the school.

"This connection will make it safer for local residents and bust congestion for people stuck in traffic."

Ms Simpson also stated that a new stream-lined procurement process will speed up contracts and get shovels in the ground as soon as possible.

"Only an LNP Government will deliver the new jobs and new roads the Sunshine Coast needs for the future."





In response to the pro Sekisui letters in The Coolum Advertiser (1/10/20):

Friends of Yaroomba is a group of residents whose desire is to see the beachfront land at Yaroomba, currently owned by Sekisui House, developed in a sensitive way in accordance with the Town Plan.

The push for high-rise apartment buildings by Sekisui and Sunshine Coast Council has been camouflaged by the much promoted ‘resort’, which includes three 7-storey hotel/serviced apartment buildings.

The main focus of the development is to construct 541 apartments in several 4-storey buildings and 67, two or three-storey dwellings. This will bring many more people to live on this small pocket of land and is completely out of character with the area’s quality of life.

As outlined recently by CoreLogic, remote working arrangements, lifestyle opportunities and a desire for lower density housing options are playing a part in strong demand in regional markets. This project design is tied to pre-Covid “normal” conditions and out of step with current and future urban trends.

Billion-dollar companies often employ public relations specialists with the expertise to discredit community organisations in the court of public opinion. Our organisation is not in the same league and maintaining a positive reputation is of paramount importance when endeavouring to raise funds for a Supreme Court appeal by Development Watch.

Our committee is focused on developing positive community relationships far into the future and beyond the Save Yaroomba campaign. We do not support bullying tactics from either side.

A look back in time

FRANCES WINDOLF
A LONG TIME COOLUM RESIDENT
WITH A PASSION FOR LOCAL HISTORY

When shopping was fun

I WAS one of many shoppers caught in last Friday's multistate shutdown of computer systems in Coles Stores. Looking back from the front of a long line of would-be buyers, I viewed the queues behind each checkout. There were no children in the crowd, and no smiles ... and as I waited, Somers' store came to mind.

'Somers' store' was an institution in Coolum, remembered fondly by a whole generation of Coolum residents. The ungainly, square yellow two-story building on the corner of The Esplanade [David Low Way] and Beach Road, was the heart of Coolum, providing everything from ice-creams to roofing nails, clothing to newspapers, and fast food to blocks of land, and it remains an important symbol

of life in Coolum in the 1960s and 1970s.

Lloyd Somers had been a professional fisherman around Sandgate and Redcliffe, catching crabs and bay prawns from a small boat. It was not the ideal occupation for a redhead, and he sought refuge from the all-pervading sunshine of that occupation by moving to Coolum in 1962 with his wife Mavis. Two months after they moved to Coolum in 1962, the area experienced a series of several cyclones within a 24-hour period over New Year. These severely damaged the upper storey of their new home and business, but Lloyd and Mavis battled on, raising five children, and becoming part of the fabric of the district. By 1974 Somers' store and their other business – L.E.Somers Real Estate – had outgrown the

corner store, with its separate front section and raised rear section, so the Somers family built a new arcade next door, encompassing a modern supermarket, newsagent, drapery and real estate office. The old building remained on the corner until 1987, when it was replaced by a modern brick structure.

One former resident recently told me "I just loved the old shop - what a curious goldmine it was – I still miss it to this day." Others remember, "going there with Dad" to buy bait for fishing expeditions along the beach. Many children spent

their pocket money on lollies, choosing "one of those, and one of them" at great length, while Mrs Crump patiently waited behind the counter, placing their chosen sweets into a white paper bag. When building began on the Caprice high-rise, kids searched for bottles, which they cashed in for sweets, or to play Pacman. Some recall packs of fabric, needles and thread provided by the store for schoolgirls. Others remember icecream, sunscreen, thongs and board wax.

When talking of Somers' store, several people have said "We were so lucky to grow up in Coolum back then". I wonder what modern children will recall of today's supermarket era?

Real Reform Real Funding

A COUPLE of weeks ago the lockdown of nursing homes ceased and we were able to properly celebrate my mum's 85th birthday in Brisbane. It has been wonderful for our family to once again visit my mother in the nursing home or to have the ability to take her out for the day. My mum had been living in the nursing home since June and has only recently been subject to lockdowns.

We are very happy with the care my mum is receiving but it could have been quite different had we been in the southern states with the pandemic and poor infection control. How-

ever, we now need to refer to nursing homes as aged care facilities - and previous reforms saw that 24/7 nursing care may not be present in some facilities. This is very much an outsourced profit making model with heavy subsidisation by the Federal Government.

The Royal Commission into Aged Care Quality and Safety's Interim Report has found "the aged care system fails to meet the needs of its older, vulnerable, citizens. It does not deliver uniformly safe and quality care, is unkind and uncaring towards older people and, in too many instances, it neglects them".
