## Barns Lane future development plans revealed

THE SITE THAT was earmarked for a Bunnings store has been sold and now the new owners have announced their vision with the proposal for the site, which flanks the motorway at the entrance to Coolum set to become an agriculture and tourism venture reliant on Sunshine Coast Council approval.

The developer's are stating that Barns Lane Farm will showcase the region's brilliance through fresh local food and educational experiences, with activities aimed to promote community, local talent and artists.


Centered around a working farm, the proposed 6.8-hectare site at Barns Lane, will feature food attractions such as a seasonal local produce hall, gin distillery, brewery, restaurant, bakery and more.

Property developer Jason Grant said that they want Barns Lane to be about 'locals'.

"We want Barns Lane Farm to be a local gathering spot and a place that draws tourists in to learn about our dynamic and diverse region.

"Local really is key for us and we aim to empower the community through a range of excitingly unique initiatives, while also committing to holistic sustainability and the environment through respon-

sible supply-chain and waste measures."

The new rural-based tourism venture is co-owned and operated by Mr Grant and successful businessman Jonathan Leishman.

The two have a working relationship which spans decades across various developments and family projects.

"To be able to combine our love and passion of the land, culture, mountains and

of course food and beer, in a setting as convenient and breathtaking as Coolum is truly an honour," Mr Leishman said.

The Council planning application will be lodged this week, with aims to open mid-2022 - pending Sunshine Coast Council assessment. Final stages will include a 26-room boutique hotel suite for rural destination weddings and event.

# ORGANIC WASTE BINS – A WHEELY GOOD IDEA?

BURIED deep in our household rubbish bin lies an opportunity that could see the Sunshine Coast divert more than half of our household bin waste from landfill, and instead turn it into a valuable resource.

Council is seeking community feedback on a proposal to introduce an opt-out third bin for garden waste which could transition to a food organics and garden organics bin service, also known as a FOGO bin.

Residents are invited to complete a short online survey and have a say on the future of waste.

Service Delivery Portfolio Councillor Christian Dickson said this was another project which had the potential to put our Sunshine Coast on a path to achieving international, national and state greenhouse gas reduction targets, and another step towards becoming Australia's most sustainable region.

"Council, State and Commonwealth governments have established waste strategies and policies which set targets to divert waste from landfill," Cr Dickson said.

"Our waste strategy sets the target to divert 55 per cent of household waste from landfill by 2025 – at the moment we sit at 34 per cent.

"Forty-three council's in New South Wales have a FOGO service, and it makes sense because it means less waste is sent to landfill – potentially extending the life of our existing facilities by many years.

"Waste becomes a resource, we reduce our region's greenhouse gas emissions and look after our environment for our children, and their children.

"To support a thriving community now and into the future it is critical that we manage our energy, waste and natural resources efficiently and sustainably.

"I encourage all of our community to have their say. Let us know the changes you'd be willing to make for a sustainable future."

Councillor Dickson said the introduction of a compulsory garden waste and FOGO bin would be another step towards Sunshine Coast Council's goal to transition to a circular economy for waste, in line with its Sunshine Coast Waste Strategy 2015 – 2025.

"Bones, lemon peels, out-of-date dairy products, lawn clippings and meat have more in common than you may think," Cr Dickson said.

"These items might seem like rubbish, but they could be converted into a valuable resource, like energy or compost, if recycled correctly.

"Council is undertaking a community survey to explore the possibility of introducing a third bin for lawn clippings and garden waste for every household as an option to improve waste management.

"At the moment, over 35,000 households have a garden waste bin.

"If all households used a garden waste bin, this could increase the total amount of material recycled by house-

holds to over 40 per cent, reducing the amount of organic waste in landfill and allow it to be recycled into mulch.

"Eventually this garden waste bin could transition to a Food Organics and Garden Organics or FOGO collection service, which means you'd put all your food scraps in the green bin along with your garden waste.

"Even foods you wouldn't put in a home compost bin could go in because the processing of the waste occurs in a controlled environment."

Cr Dickson said our region's organic waste could be turned into high quality compost which could be put to good use in parks, gardens and farms, instead of rotting in a landfill and producing methane – a greenhouse gas much more potent than carbon dioxide.

"Or it could be converted into a fuel to make electricity.

"Based on our research and conversations with other councils, we have some ideas on how we expect a FOGO bin service to work such as changing how frequently the bin is collected and using kitchen tidy bins with special bags to contain the smell.

"We want to hear the community's feedback before any decision is made."

COOLUM Beach Surf Club's 'Surf Woman of the Year' representative is inviting the community to get down for a beach clean on Coolum main beach this coming Monday afternoon in aid of the annual Clean Up Australia Day event.

Jess Appel is a passionate beach lover and environmentalist who are using the Clean Up event to promote both environmental and surf awareness.

"It is my aim to incorporate environmental education into surf awareness by promoting the importance of our role

in preserving our coastal habitat, through events like Clean Up Australia Day and I am hoping this event will bring recognition to our local and greater community towards the need for conservation and protection of our coastal and marine ecosystems."

In honour of Clean Up Australia Day on March 7, Coolum Beach Surf Life Saving Club (SLSC) will be hosting an early Beach Clean Up Event on Monday, March 1, from 4.30-6.00pm.

"We are asking that people join us downstairs on the beachside of our SLSC to be segregated into two groups. We

will then parade to Stumers Creek and also from the SLSC to Second Bay. We do ask if you could please make sure you wear your hats, closed in shoes and gardening gloves for the event," Jess said.

Jess is also hoping that as many business and community leaders get involved with Ninderry MP Dan Purdie saying that he was proud to support Jessica's Clean Up Australia Day event, and encouraged the Coolum community to get behind it.

# A look back in time

## THE SANDS OF OUR TIMES

IT WOULD be fair to say that most people are attracted to our area by our beaches – the waves, or the sandy shore. Grains of sand, small as they may be, are immensely valuable to our economy, and it is interesting to consider the ways in which this value has been exhibited. We are all familiar with the attraction of our beaches and ocean to would-be residents and visitors, as exhibited in local land sales during the last century, especially in today's residential market, but there are other aspects of our beaches which have repeatedly concerned local residents.

Currently, many of our beaches are under stress from activities ranging from proposed building activities to

transport problems and sand pumping, and we are concerned for the future. However, beach stress is, unfortunately, not a new problem in our area. Since early in our residential history, the lure of minerals marking our sands with 'peculiar black sand' deposits – rutile, ilmenite, monazite and zircon – has attracted mineral-seekers to our area.

The first recorded venture of this type occurred in 1929, when a syndicate approached the Moreton Sugar Mill Board to transport sand from 'a peculiar black sand deposit' at Coolum to Nambour, for expected sales to Germany. We are told that the cartage was a "very good thing in the way of freight for the mill", but no other records about this

venture have been found, and it is possible that the onset of the 1929 Depression quashed the idea.

By the mid-1950s, however, sand mining on beaches on the eastern seaboard of Australia became a keen subject of discussion, as rutile (for titanium), zircon (for ceramics and nuclear reactor elements) and monazite (for thorium, a nuclear fuel), were dry-mined for mineral sands. In February 1956, the Coolum Beach Progress Association 'sent an urgent telegram to the Minister for Mines objecting to mining of frontal dunes'. Indeed, they were so concerned that they also moved to 'have a petition prepared for public signatures' as well. Under pressure from local protestors, the Minister inspected the Coolum area, agreeing that mining companies should be required to protect trees in the area, but 'he repeated the government view that sand mining would not disturb anybody or anything as there were few houses between Coolum and Noosa.'

Fortunately, around this time the government was changed, and historian Helen Gregory tells us that "the change of government and the plan to develop the area for tourism saved most of the beaches from the sand miners but they were permitted to move further north to Fraser Island." Although other attempts were made until 1966, fortunately none were successful and our beaches remain safe – we hope!

FACEBOOK has been in the news this week after banning Australian news content and inadvertently taking down government and community sites that people rely on for important messages. It brought an instant backlash against Facebook, after what appeared to be a snap decision for which no-one was prepared.

The decision to ban news from Facebook's platform certainly put "big tech" in the spotlight. I know I certainly have my concerns, especially at the way social media is allowed to be used by children to create an extremely unhealthy environment in which cyber

bullying thrives unchallenged, while the tech companies creating the platforms that allow it to happen reap billions. The whole situation makes me uncomfortable.

You see, for me, after working with them every day I know that our teenagers, while appearing full of bravado, are deeply vulnerable. They don't deserve to be pawns in an impossibly profitable game, while their mental health and their sense of self is attacked mercilessly. Yes, as parents we have a role, but it's a role our own parents never had to fill. If there were more checks and balances around the tech

companies themselves, more regulations to support children - parents wouldn't have to feel as if they need to monitor their child's every action when they are online.

Facebook has shown that it doesn't seem to believe that it can be controlled by rules. It doesn't appear to have a conscience around the content that appears on its platforms. It certainly doesn't believe it's a publisher in the way that a newspaper is a publisher and it has shown it will fight all the way to keep things this way. I just wish there was more that we could do, that more was being done, to protect children from the harm that occurs on social media and that today's children didn't have to navigate this uncharted world on their own. Maybe one day this world will be regulated and we won't see the harm we see that is being done in this unregulated space because our children deserve to have their childhood free from bullying and abuse.

The submissions for the CEP are being reviewed, and an updated draft will be provided for a further public review. We continue to be contacted by residents impacted by our current housing crisis, and I thank our community who have assisted enormously in efforts. The Housing Action Group is working rapidly on both short- and longer-term solutions, and currently we await the re-

sponse from State Government surrounding the constraints by definition for second dwellings, infrastructure charges and other contributors to the current situation.

The COVID-19 vaccine rollout has commenced for those in the high priority group, with the vaccine hub for our region based at the Sunshine Coast University Hospital. The Lake MacDonal Dam upgrade by Seqwater is to be reassessed due to information that emerged during the procurement stage which predicted that project costs would be significantly higher than anticipated, hence the lowering of the lake will now

not proceed in 2021. Seqwater has assured that it will keep our community updated as the assessment progresses with an approximate completion date mid-year.

There has been concerns on Facebook regarding tree clearing, highlighting the need again for a call out for residents to contact our Councillors or myself for information so that what is shared online can be productive versus divisive.
