

## COOLUM'S COMMUNITY GARDEN FINALLY SET TO GROW

THE COOLUM community will finally be seeing some tangible work happening in Jack Morgan Park over the coming months in relation to the establishment of Coolum's very own community garden with the building of an accessible pop up garden which will serve as a way to get the project moving.

The community garden which will be known as 'Coolum Common' will this Saturday June 19 be hosting a fundraising stall at the Barely Worn Market from 8am at the Coolum Civic Centre to raise funds for the project and to inform people on what the community garden is all about.

With help from the Coolum Men's Shed along with an initial grant from Sunshine Coast Council and with the support of Coolum Business and Tourism, the first pop up garden site for the main garden site will be built over winter.

Volunteer and spokesperson for Coolum Common, Claire Baker explained that the Coolum accessible garden will serve as a way to get peo-

### ROBODEBT

Dear editor,

Five years on and not one Federal Government Minister, including Social Services Minister, Linda Reynolds, the minister responsible, is dismissed.

The Commonwealth's welfare system's automated "Robodebt" scheme is a dark history in welfare culture, 2015-2019. Exposed for the scam it is, its victims wait for restitution through the courts, while its architects remain silent. Instead of the protective "social security" for our poor and disadvantaged, this disastrous scheme, illegally demanded supposed debt and overcharged repayments into

thousands from vulnerable welfare recipients.

It was tantamount to grand theft. There was no explanation as to how and why. The Commonwealth is now charged with refunding \$751million recovered in invalid debts. How did they get it so wrong?

Thanks to Paul Keating and successive political parties of both sides, income averaging for welfare recipients is a perpetual nightmare. From 2015, applicants suffered an automated debt demand, without the details. It drove many to suffer PTSD and even suicide, without knowing how they failed.

\$112million is to be com-

pensated to 381,000 victims. Taxpayers are footing the bill, which may amount to \$1.8billion. No one can be compensated for the psychological and physical harm to innocent victims. The buck stops at the top.

ple involved and show that the project is moving forward.

"So far we have about 14 volunteers, however we have had nothing on site, so the accessible garden beds is a way to keep people engaged and people can see something is happening," Claire said.

The long term plan for Coolum Common is for it to be designed by the community and for the community to use.

"We will do more community engagement in order to get the design right and it will be an outdoor meeting space - a place to learn how to live sustainably and we envision it to be a place where people can learn.

"At the moment our focus is on getting incorporated so that we can apply for more grants and deliver the accessible garden - everything is dependent on funding and we don't have any larger gardening or permaculture group behind us, so we have to do everything on our own via grants and fundraising."

Whilst many people in Coolum do have gardens of their own, community gardens serve as a way to connect people to their community,


especially after the social isolation that has resulted from COVID.

"People are looking for connection and people are looking to make new friends and there's also many people who have downsized and want that gardening area and Coolum Common will also be a way to meet like minded people and learn," Claire explained.

To support Coolum Common come along to the Barely Worn Market at Coolum Civic Centre this Saturday from 8am to learn more about how you

can support the project and be involved. The stall will host a seed, seedling and plant sale and will also serve as a way to share the community vision for the site and people will also be able to ask questions and chat with the group.

# OVER \$200,000 FUNDING WIN FOR COMMUNITY GROUPS

LOCAL community groups have received a funding boost through Round 108 of the Gambling Community Benefit Fund Grant and the first round of the Investing in Queensland Women Grant.

Ms Simpson said that over \$200,000 in grants will be paid to local groups in the Maroochydore electorate, including:

\*Mudjimba Surf Lifesaving Club will receive \$34,920 to upgrade the facility;

\*The Queensland Country Women's Association will receive \$24,125 to upgrade the roof;

\*IFYS Limited will receive \$6,500 to create peer-led DFC education through online narratives;

\*Beyond DV Ltd will receive \$14,500 to deliver domestic violence workshops for boys and girls (16-18 years) and their parents.

"It is really exciting to see the community benefiting from these funding opportunities. These grants assist our organisations to continue to provide important services within our local community," Ms Simpson said.

"And it was great to see Mudjimba Lifesaving Club receive funding for further club upgrades, as they celebrate their 25th birthday this year.

"It was also really fantastic that Maroochydore had two wins with the first round of the Investing in Queensland Women grant."

"I encourage all local groups, however big or small, to apply for available grant funding and to contact my office to discuss a letter of support or for advice."

The Gambling Community Fund is a quarterly program providing funding of up to \$35,000 to community groups. Round 110 of the funding is now open and closes midnight on June 30, 2021.

Round two of the Investing in Queensland Women Round Two will open in July 2021.

Deckchairs, by Jean McConnell, is directed by Barbara Ryan a newcomer to Coolum Theatre Players (CTP) and the Sunshine Coast. Barbara directed and performed in regional Victoria, and previously Coffs Harbour for many years and recently relocated to the Sunshine Coast with her husband Bob. With a string of performing and directing credits to her name, Barbara is working with a cast of 10

When moving to Marcoola and living only a short distance from the Nambour Show grounds we started to make the Sunshine Coast Show an annual event finding the charm of the smaller regional agricultural show.

I find there is so much love and attention that goes into the Sunshine Coast Show and try to get around to all exhibits, wood chopping, ring events, art and handicrafts, farm animals and much more. This year the winning iced cake was a beautiful turtle cake and the love theme came across in many of the wonderful handcrafted quilts. Of course there are plenty of tasty food, beverages and side show alley attractions to enjoy as well.

Clearly, I love the Sunshine Coast Show and so do many other people with over 8,000 people attending on the Friday public holiday. The bringing together of the rural and other regional people for a celebration of what we treasure in our community is special. I really was impressed by the young girls and boys competing hard in the woodchops or leading feisty cows around the show ring following on family traditions.

Yes, there is a great deal of love in Nambour especially at show time.

# A look back in time

A LONG TIME COOLUM RESIDENT  
WITH A PASSION FOR LOCAL HISTORY

## AN ANNIVERSARY WORTH CELEBRATING

ON JUNE 30, 2021, Coolum will reach an important historical milestone. That day will mark the seventy-fifth anniversary of the day when Coolum Beach was officially declared a township, on June 30, 1946. At that time, the township of Coolum Beach, which included today's Coolum Beach, Mount Coolum, Yaroomba, Point Arkwright, South Peregian and Peregian Springs had a population comprised of 155 men, women and children – 107 adults who were twenty-one and older, and 48 minors. There were 55 households in that area and twenty-two of the householders were farmers,

nineteen were retired, six were labourers, and two were drivers, and there was one shopkeeper, one school teacher, one postmaster, one salesman, one bus proprietor and a "bait man". Fifteen people lived on their own, there were eighteen two-person households, sixteen families of between three and five persons, and six families in households of six to ten people. When Coolum Beach township was declared, there were 29 children attending the State School, on the corner of Warrack Street and South Coolum Road. However, over the next five years, that number varied dramatically as new families

– including the Lambert and Parnell families - moved to the area, and others left. At that time, there was still only one road out of town, which was considered to be "almost impossible to keep in any reasonable state of repair". There was only one shop, no doctor, no nurse, no electricity, no piped water ... and people still had to empty their own toilet pans! At least fifteen or twenty families moved to the area, and left again within six months of a year, realising that the inexpensive land that they had bought with deferred army pay or cheap war service loans was not as idyllic as they dreamed it would be, so Coolum Beach remained a very small hamlet.

Fifty years later, the area was very different, and the 155 residents of five decades before had grown to 6999, even though the area encompassed by the name "Coolum" had become limited as "suburbs" had developed around the central core. In 1996, 1054 Coolum residents had been born overseas, and only 38 per cent of residents [2659 people] had been at the same address five years previously. At that time 1524 residents [22 per cent] were aged under 15, with most attending one of the two excellent schools.

The fiftieth anniversary of Coolum Beach was celebrated by a black-tie ball in the Coolum Civic Centre, where plaques were presented to five residents who had lived in Coolum fifty years before – Merv and Beryl Doyle, Ray Wintzloff, and John Windolf and his sister Caryll Murphy. None are left, but their legacy lives on. ... Happy 75th birthday, Coolum!

#### STATE BUDGET

This week, the State Government handed down its second Budget, but unfortunately for the majority of locals, there was little to get excited about. There are some local highlights worth celebrating, with Coolum High set to benefit from a \$11.2million investment this financial

year for a range of infrastructure projects including building extensions and classrooms, as well as \$4.5m for a new administration building for North Arm State School, and \$450,000 for Bli Bli State School. These are great outcomes, although I am disappointed there was no new money for a performance hall for Coolum High, or to fast track the long overdue air-conditioning at Coolum State School.

Other welcome investment includes just over \$1million for pedestrian access at the intersection of Scrub Road and David Low Way, and an additional \$450,000 for the Motorway duplication planning process. The State is also chipping in more than \$1million to seal a section of Zgrajewski Road. These are all important projects I have been lobbying for, so it's great to see the funding allocated, although there's

still much more needed.

At a time when more and more people are choosing to call the Sunshine Coast home, we need to see more money being invested into our road network. We need to fast-track major infrastructure projects like the upgrade to the Coolum roundabout, and upgrades to major arterial roads like the Yandina Coolum Road and Bli Bli Road, which are no longer fit for purpose.

While I welcome a funding commitment of \$1.9billion over four years for social housing, and a new \$1billion Housing Investment Fund, there is so much more that needs to be done, which this Budget simply doesn't deliver.

part of our community. Now is your opportunity to help shape the transport options to benefit you and your family in the future. To wrap up, I urge you to have your say on the Mass Transit Project before consultation closes on June 22, 2021.

We have some huge sporting events coming up - June 25-27 will see the Women's State of Origin, the Aussie Stingers Water Polo team are hosting a farewell match at St Andrews before they go to Tokyo and of course Sunshine Coast Lightning are striking back, sitting top of the ladder. Make sure you show your team colours and support, for event information go to events.sunshinecoast.qld.gov.au.


